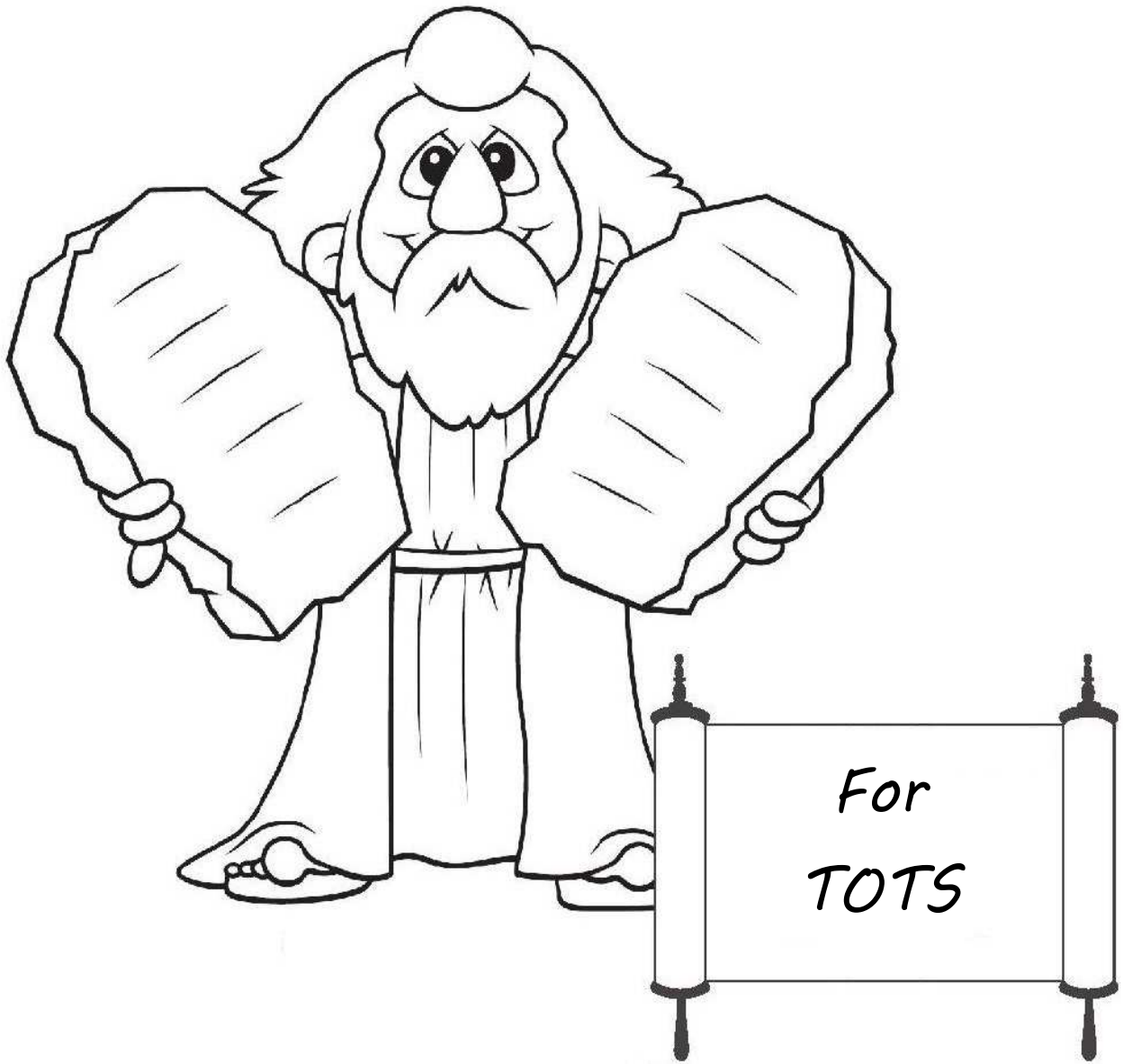


# The Ten Commandments

~ 5<sup>th</sup> ~

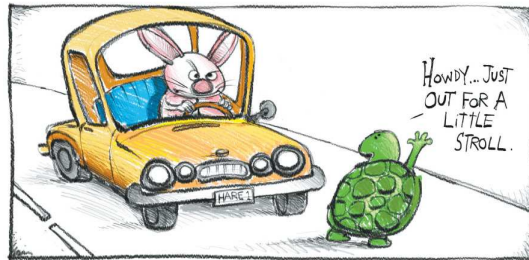
Honor your father and your

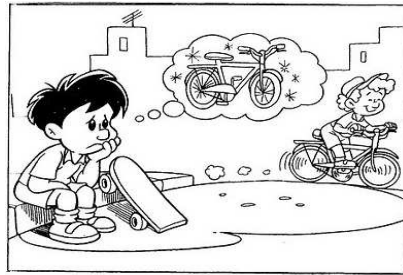
~ 9<sup>th</sup> ~
