
The Pesach (בּכה) Lamb



This month is the beginning of months to you, the first month of the year.

On the TENTH day of the month each household is to take a lamb.

The lamb is to be perfect, a year old male from the sheep or the goats.

You will keep it until the FOURTEENTH day of the same month and kill it between the evenings.

Take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses where they eat it.

And the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I shall pass over you, and let the plague not come on you to destroy you when I smite the land of Mitsrayim.

'And this day shall become to you a remembrance. And you shall observe it as a festival to Adonai throughout your generations – observe it as a festival, an everlasting law.
